Our NETP programme offers 12 month placements with 12 study days which includes 1 graduate certificate paper (Level 7); permanent contracts for Te Whatu Ora – Waitaha Canterbury employees; and a mixture of permanent and fixed term contracts for partnering organisations.

Our NESP programme offers employment in an inpatient workplace with a 10 week community experience; 2 post-grad papers (Level 8); and permanent contracts.
